All members were present:

1. Bob Johnston reported more about the next Golden Domer and the various items to be included such as the lengthy, but inspirational Fr Joe story.
2. Bill Dunn reported that he had made contact with Tom Sullivan to confirm that he would be attending reunion for the Class of '66. Sullivan also agreed to make a brief presentation about NDSA. He will receive Talking Points and a suggested speech to read-whatever is most comfortable for him. The Class of '66 the only reunion class not covered by current and past NDSA Directors
