Club	Description of Outstanding Club Initiative(s), success(es), or problem(s) (type 250 words or less)
Detroit	16 members of the Detroit club are providing professional services to 10 Catholic schools in the Detroit archdioceses. For each school, the ND volunteers conduct a "Process" that allows to "facilitate" and lead the school team to identify the specific "environment" (SWOT) for that particular school. The team (5-8), composed of Principal, Pastor, admin, volunteers and teachers must discuss and agree on Issues, environment, objectives, plans and assignments. In addition to creating a simple plan, with defined actions, the Team also draws closer together to understand and acknowledge the problems and how to work together and energize others in the parish to move forward. This "teamwork" and understanding that they can take new steps, try new actions, and reach outside their comfort zone is just as important as the actual Plan. The process usually covers 6-8 meetings, each lasting 2-3 hours.

Ann Arbor	5 Seniors participated in Warm the Children, an Ann Arbor community project in which volunteers supervise shopping for children's clothes with funds provided by donations solicited from the community. 2-3 Seniors participate monthly in visits to the VA Hospital in Ann Arbor. 5 seniors worked on our Tax Assistance Program where we obtained \$54, 383 in refunds (State and Federal) for our clients. 10 seniors raised > \$10,000 in scholarship funds for our current ND students.
