Jackson	2 seniors are active with the Jackson Catholic Schools Consortium working to develop a long range business plan to support viability of the Catholic schools in Jackson
Detroit	Detroit seniors and other club members are directly involved in support of four Catholic schools within the archdiocese. They work in teams of 2 with a well defined program and interact with various committees of the schools, primarily on issues related to enrollment and fundraising. This work is being done in cooperation with the Archdiocese of Detroit which has been helpful in establishing access to individual parishes. Seniors are also involved with the hospital ministry program and have volunteers assigned to hospitals by county. During tax season, seniors have been involved in the tax assistance program.
